Delicious Views: NYC apartments with chef's kitchens overlooking panoramic vistas

Most people regard indie darling [Pieces of April](#) as a quirky Thanksgiving movie, but the real estate community appears to treat it as a cautionary tale: High-end appliances and generous counter and storage space give New Yorkers the means to seamlessly create a Thanksgiving dinner in their own kitchens. Elsewhere in the apartments, spectacular views and impeccably crafted interiors make for the ideal setting for a formal dinner party, a quiet night, and everything in between.

Stephen Brockman, Partner at [Deborah Berke Partners](#), notices that the number of New Yorkers cooking at home has grown in recent years. Because of this, the firm makes it a goal to open the kitchen up to the living area to keep the connection alive, and to make the kitchen a place where it is a pleasure to work. Access to daylight is a key factor in this, which inspired large windows with sweeping skyline and river views.

On a tour of a model unit at [77 Greenwich Street](#), Mr. Brockman pointed out that the refrigerator and dishwasher are integrated so as to keep reflecting light to a minimum and not distract from the spectacular views from the apartments starting 150 feet off the ground. An unobstructed floating island was designed to serve as a part of the room rather than a piece of architecture. But the kitchen is not all style and no substance - it cleverly hides a wide variety of storage in places the cook is likeliest to need it.

Indeed, kitchens in apartments throughout Manhattan, northern Brooklyn, and Long Island City are enhanced with spectacular views in addition to high-end appliances and finishes. In these settings, the only danger is that one might burn dinner from being unable to look away from the windows!
